Red Queen; sex Abstract One of the greatest challenges for evolutionary biology is explaining the widespread occurrence of sexual reproduction and the associated process of genetic recombination A large number of theories have been developed that provide a sufficient short-term advantage for sex to offset its two-fold cost

Current hypotheses for the evolution of sex and recombination

sites (Red Queen hypothesis); and the ability of sex to purge bad genomes if deleterious mutations act synergis-tically (mutational deterministic hypothesis) Current theoretical and experimental evidence seems to favor the hypothesis that sex breaks down selection interference between new mutants, or it acts as a mechanism to shuf-
